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Edit `openssl.cnf` file:

```
sudo nano /etc/ssl/openssl.cnf
```

Add this line at the top:

```
openssl_conf = openssl_init
```

And add these lines at the end:

```
[openssl_init]
ssl_conf = ssl_sect

[ssl_sect]
system_default = system_default_sect

[system_default_sect]
CipherString = DEFAULT@SECLEVEL=1
```

It works for me. :)

For any system add at the top of `openssl.cnf` :

```
openssl_conf = default_conf
```

and at end of `openssl.cnf` :

- For Debian add:

```
[system_default_sect]
MinProtocol = TLSv1.0
CipherString = DEFAULT@SECLEVEL=2
```

- For Ubuntu 20.04 add:

```
[system_default_sect]
```

```
MinProtocol = TLSv1    #important !
```

```
CipherString = DEFAULT@SECLEVEL=2 # in my case works good with very old software
```
